Welcome to Boundary Transit

Boundary Transit provides accessible transportation service for everyone in the community.

Boundary Transit operates an on-request transit service providing door-to-door service for people with a disability and curb-to-curb service for others.

Local service is provided within Grand Forks and scheduled trips are provided between Grand Forks and Greenwood on Fridays.

About Your Transit System

Funding is cost-shared between the Regional District of Kootenay Boundary and BC Transit.

Decisions about fares, routes and service levels are made by the Regional District Board based on information and planning provided by BC Transit.

Boundary Transit is operated by the Interior Health Authority.

Booking a Trip

Call 250-443-2179 at any time and leave a message with your name, phone number, pick up and drop off locations, and the time you wish to travel. Return calls will be made between 8:00 – 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 – 4:00 p.m.

There are two types of trips:

1. regular trips, at least once a week, or
2. one-time trips, such as shopping or social visits

It is important that you call and cancel your trip the day before or before 8:00 a.m. Someone else may be able to travel in your place.

Pick-up Window

When you call the office, the dispatcher will confirm your pick-up time. You need to be ready fifteen minutes before your scheduled pick-up time.



Attendants Travel Free

Customers using wheelchairs or scooters, may travel with an attendant. An attendant is someone needed to help you make the trip. Attendants travel for free. Let your transit operator know if the person travelling with you is your attendant. Attendants must board and exit at the same stop as the customer requiring assistance and help to load and secure mobility aids on the bus.

The Bus is a Safe Place

Each transit bus is radio equipped to contact local police, ambulance and other emergency services. Transit operators are safe strangers and are trained to assist a child or adult in difficulty.
